# MERCHANDISE MARKS ACT, 1941: PROPOSED PROHIBITION OF THE USE OF A CERTAIN MARK

In terms of section 13 of the Merchandise Marks Act, 1941 (Act No. 17 of 1941), I give notice that the National Radiation Protection Authority has requested me to prohibit, under 15(1) of that Act, the use by any person other than the National Radiation Protection Authority of the mark shown below in connection with any trade, business, profession or occupation or in connection with a trade mark, mark or trade description applied to goods.
