## Appropriation Act, 2020

## ACT

**To: appropriate amounts of money to meet the financial requirements of the State during the financial year ending 31 March 2021.**

BE IT ENACTED as passed by the Parliament, and assented to by the President, of the Republic of Namibia as follows:

### 1. Appropriation of amounts of money for the financial requirements of State

Subject to the State Finance Act, 1991 (Act [No. 31 of 1991](#)) the amounts of money shown in the Schedule are appropriated for the financial requirements of the State during the financial year ending 31 March 2021 as a charge to the State Revenue Fund.

### 2. Short title

This Act is called the Appropriation Act, 2020.
