


The community service order may commence with effect from 3 October 2018. 	
Reasons for order:	
TOMMASI J (January J concurring): <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The conviction and sentence are in accordance with justice and may be confirmed. The condition however is not in accordance with justice. The condition reads as follow: '... on condition that the accused completes 315 hours of community service cleaning work at Okongo Police Station.' The condition is vague. The court corrected the condition to read as per the recommendation by the Community Service Orders (CSO) officer.
