REGULATIONS RELATING TO AMBULANCE FEES

The council of the Municipality of Usakos has under section 242 of the Municipal Ordinance, 1963 (Ordinance 13 of 1963), made the regulations set out in the Schedule.

The said regulations have been approved by the President under section 243 of the said Municipal Ordinance, 1963.

SCHEDULE

DEFINITIONS:

- 1. In these regulations, unless the context otherwise indicates, a word or an expression defined in the Municipal Ordinance, 1963 (Ordinance 13 of 1963), has a corresponding meaning, and -
 - (i) "council" means the council of the Municipality of Usakos;
 - (ii) "journey" means the route travelled by an ambulance from its point of departure at the ambulance's base up to its return to such base;
 - (iii) "patient" means -
 - (a) any person transported from -
 - (i) one place to another in order to receive treatment as referred to in section 1 of the Hospitals Ordinance, 1972 (Ordinance 14 of 1972); or
 - (ii) any place where he received the said treatment to any other place; or
 - (b) any deceased person transported from one place to another;
 - (iv) "the Ordinance" means the Municipal Ordinance, 1963 (Ordinance 13 of 1963); and
 - (v) "urban areas" means that area within the Municipal area of Usakos, taken up by any approved township as defined in section 1 of the Townships and Division of Land Ordinance, 1963 (Ordinance 11 of 1963), or by any location or native village as defined in section 1 of the Natives (Urban Areas) Proclamation, 1951 (Proclamation 56 of 1951), and includes any land situated between any such approved township and any such location or native village.

AMBULANCE FEES:

2. (1) The fees set out in the Annexure hereto, shall be payable to the council in connection with the transportation of any patient by an ambulance of the council.

- (2) The fees referred to in subregulation (1) shall be due and payable by-
 - (a) the patient concerned;
 - (b) the parents or legal guardian of a patient who is a minor;
 - (c) the curator of a patient who has been placed under curatorship in terms of any law; or
 - (d) the estate of a patient who is a deceased person.

ANNEXURE

TRANSPORTATION FEES:

- 1. (1) The fees payable for the transportation of any patient from one place to another within the urban area, shall be -
 - (a) R24,00 if only one patient is being transported;
 - (b) R12,00 per patient if two patients are being transported simultaneously at any given moment during a single journey; and
 - (c) R8,00 per patient if three or more patients are being transported simultaneously at any given moment during a single journey: Provided that if any patient is transported from one hospital to another within the urban area and is again transported back to the first-mentioned hospital, the transportation back to such hospital shall be free of charge.
 - (2) The fees payable for the transportation of any patient from one place to another where one or both places are situated outside the urban area, shall be calculated at 90 cents per kilometre of the total distance travelled by the ambulance during the journey: Provided that if more than one patient is being transported simultaneously at any given moment during a single journey, the fees payable in respect of each patient shall be calculated according to the following formula:

$$Y = \frac{A}{B} x C$$

in which -

- Y = the amount payable by or on behalf of any patient concerned;
- A = the distance which the ambulance would have travelled if the patient concerned was the only patient being transported;
- B = the sum total of the various distances which the ambulance would have travelled if all the patients which have been transported during such journey, were being transported separately; and
- C = the fees payable for the total distance which the ambulance travelled during such journey:

Provided further that the fees so payable shall not be less than -

- (i) R24,00 if only one patient is being transported;
- (ii) R12,00 per patient if two patients are being transported simultaneously at any given moment during such journey; and
- (iii) R8,00 per patient if three or more patients are being transported simultaneously at any given moment during such journey.

ADDITIONAL FEES:

- 2. (1) For the use by any patient of oxygen or any other items which cannot be re-used, a fee which is equal to the actual cost thereof shall be payable in addition to the fees referred to in item 1.
 - (2) In the case of a patient suffering from a contagious or infectious disease, a fee of R10,00 shall be payable in addition to the fees referred to in item 1 and subitem (1) of this item: Provided that if more than one patient suffering from a contagious or infectious disease is being transported simultaneously at any given moment during a single journey, the said fee of R10,00 shall be divided by the number of patients and each patient shall be liable for the payment of his *pro rata* share.
