APPLICATION THAT A PORTION OF DISTRICT ROAD 1212 BE DEVIATED: DISTRICT OF MARIENTAL

In terms of section 16(3) of the Roads Ordinance, 1972 (Ordinance 17 of 1972), it is hereby made known that application has been made to the Chairman of the Roads Board of Mariental that the portion of district road 1212 described in paragraph (a) of the Schedule and shown on sketch-map P1518 by the symbols A-C-B, be deviated from the route so described and shown, to the route described in paragraph (b) of the Schedule and shown on sketch-map P1518 by the symbols A-B.

A copy of this notice and the said sketch-map, being a sketch-map of the area concerned on which the road to which the application refers and other proclaimed, minor and private roads in that area are shown, shall for the full period of thirty days mentioned below lie open to inspection at the offices of the Permanent Secretary: Works, Transport and Communication, Windhoek, and the Roads Superintendent, Mariental, during normal office hours.

Every person having any objection to the above-mentioned application is hereby commanded to lodge his or her objection in writing with the grounds upon which it is based clearly and specifically therein stated, with the Chairman of Roads Boards, Private Bag 12005, Ausspannplatz, within a period of thirty days from the date of publication of this notice.

SCHEDULE

- (a) From a point (A on sketch-map P1518) on the farm Remainder of Kaukerus 141 generally east-north-eastwards across the said farm to a point (C on sketch-map P1518) on the said farm, thence generally north-north-westwards across the said farm to a point (B on sketch-map P1518) on the said farm.
- (b) From a point (A on sketch-map P1518) on the farm Remainder of Kaukerus 141 generally northwards and more and more north-north-eastwards to a point (B on sketch-map P1518) on the said farm.
