#### CHARACTERISTICS OF COMMEMORATIVE COINS TO BE ISSUED BY THE BANK OF NAMIBIA TO COMMEMORATE THE OLYMPIC GAMES 1996

In terms of section 22(3) of the Bank of Namibia Act, 1990 (Act 8 of 1990), the Bank of Namibia hereby announces the characteristics of coins to be issued by the Bank and which have been approved by the Minister of Finance under section 22(2) of the Bank of Namibia Act, 1990.

1. Coins will be issued in the following denominations:

- 10 Namibia Dollars (N\$10)
- 100 Namibia Dollars (N\$100)

2. On the obverse side of the coins the following features appear:

The Namibian National coat-of-arms over the year 1996 and the words "Republic of Namibia" (in capital letters).

3. On the reverse side of the coins the following feature appears:

A pictorial presentation of a cheetah, in full natural colour, superimposed on a sprinting athlete with the word "Olympic Games 1996" above them.

4. The \$100 coin is made of gold and the \$10 coin is made of silver. The coins all have a diameter of 37mm with a plain edge.
