SEA FISHERIES ACT, 1992: DETERMINATION OF TOTAL ALLOWABLE CATCH IN RESPECT OF ROCK LOBSTER

Under section 15 of the Sea Fisheries Act, 1992 (Act No. 29 of 1992), and after consultation with the Sea Fishery Advisory Council, I hereby determine that the Total Allowable Catch in respect of rock lobster for the allocation of quotas during the 1997/98 rock lobster season commencing on 1 November 1997 and ending on 30 April 1998, shall be 260 metric tons, which shall, in relation to each area mentioned in the first column of the table set out below, for the purpose of allocating quotas in respect of the period specified opposite such area in the second column of that table, be apportioned as specified opposite such area in the third column of that table:

CHARGES AND FEES IN RESPECT OF LETTING OF HOSTELS, HOLIDAY BUNGALOWS, RESORT FACILITIES AND CRECHÈ
