ELECTORAL ACT, 1992: PROVISIONAL SUPPLEMENTARY NATIONAL VOTERS' REGISTER FOR THE REGIONAL COUNCIL ELECTIONS

Under section 21(b) of the Electoral Act, 1992 (Act No. 24 of 1992), read with section 28 of that Act, I hereby give notice that copies of the provisional supplementary national voters' register for every constituency in each region prepared under section 21, shall be available for inspection at the Regional Governor's Offices of each region, and at the Head Office of the Directorate of Elections, corner of Mandume Ndemufayo and Parsival Streets, Windhoek, during normal office hours between 08:00 and 17:00.

The period within which objections may be made in respect of the names of voters appearing on that register shall be from the day of publication of this notice until 23 October 1998.

ELECTORAL ACT, 1992: DESIGNATION OF MAGISTRATES FOR THE PURPOSES OF SECTION 19

Under section 19(1) of the Electoral Act, 1992 (Act No. 24 of 1992), I hereby -

- (a) designate, for the purposes of that section, the magistrate, additional magistrate or assistant magistrate of a magisterial district in which a constituency is situated, or if a constituency is situated in more than one magisterial district, the magistrate, additional magistrate or acting magistrate of any one of those magisterial districts; and
- (b) withdraw Government Notice No. 129 of 19 September 1992, as amended by Government Notice No. 194 of 21 October 1994.
