DETERMINATION OF ROYALTY IN RESPECT OF CERTAIN SEMI-PRECIOUS STONES

Under section 114(1)(c) of the Minerals (Prospecting and Mining) Act, 1992 (Act No. 33 of 1992), I hereby determine that the holder of a mining claim or a mining licence who has won or mined in the course of any prospecting or mining operations carried on by him or her, and the holder of any non-exclusive prospecting licence, exclusive prospecting licence or mineral deposit retention licence who has found or incidentally won in the course of any prospecting operations carried on by him or her, any Orange Garnet or Green Garnet, or Green Tourmaline, Blue Tourmaline or Bi-Coloured Tourmaline, shall be liable to pay to the Mining Commissioner a royalty of five percent of the market value of the said semi-precious stones, with effect from 1 April 1999.

DECLARATION OF OTJIWARONGO (EXTENSION 6) TO BE AN APPROVED TOWNSHIP

In terms of section 13 of the Townships and Division of Land Ordinance, 1963 (Ordinance No. 11 of 1963), I hereby declare the area situated on Portion 30 of the farm Otjiwarongo Townlands South No. 308 in the Municipal Area of Otjiwarongo, Registration Division D, and represented by the General Plan D80 (A198/95) to be an approved township.

1. Name of township

The township shall be called Otjiwarongo (Extension 6).

2. Composition of township

The township comprises 74 erven numbered 1809 to 1882 and streets as indicated on General Plan D80 (A198/95).

3. Conditions of title

The following conditions shall be registered in favour of the Municipal Council of Otjiwarongo against the title deeds of all erven:

- "(a) The erf shall only be used for purposes which are in accordance with, and the use or occupation of the erf shall at all times be subject to, the provisions of the Otjiwarongo Town Planning Scheme, prepared and approved in terms of the Town Planning Ordinance, 1954 (Ordinance No. 18 of 1954).
- (b) The building value of a dwelling unit, including the outbuildings, to be erected on the erf, shall be at least N\$150 000,00.".
