PROMULGATION OF ACT OF PARLIAMENT

The following Act which has been passed by the Parliament and signed by the President in terms of the Namibian Constitution is hereby published in terms of Article 56 of that Constitution.

ROAD TRAFFIC AMENDMENT ACT, 1999

ACT

To amend the Road Traffic Ordinance, 1967, to make provision for evidential breath analysis; to increase the motor vehicle licence fees, motor vehicle registration fee, motor vehicle dealer's licence fees and other miscellaneous fees; and to provide for incidental matters.

(Signed by the President on 15 March 1999)

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of the Republic of Namibia, as follows:-

1. The following section is hereby substituted for section 140 of the principal Ordinance:

"Driving while under the influence of intoxicating liquor or a drug having a narcotic effect, or with excessive amount of alcohol in blood or breath

- 140. (1) Any person who on a public road -
- (a) drives a vehicle; or
- (b) occupies the driver's seat of a motor vehicle of which the engine is running,

while under the influence of intoxicating liquor or a drug having a narcotic effect, shall be guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding N\$8 000 or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding two years, or to both such fine and imprisonment.

- (2) Any person who on a public road -
- (a) drives a vehicle; or
- (b) occupies the driver's seat of a motor vehicle of which the engine is running,

while the concentration of alcohol in any specimen of blood taken from any part of his or her body exceeds 0,079 grams per 100 millilitres, shall be guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding N\$8 000 or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding two years, or to both such fine and imprisonment.

(3) Where in any prosecution for an offence under subsection (2), it is proved that the concentration of alcohol in any specimen of blood taken from any part of the body of the person concerned exceeded 0,079 grams per 100 millilitres at any time within two hours after the alleged offence, it shall be presumed, in the absence of evidence to the contrary, that such concentration exceeded 0,079 grams per 100 millilitres at the time of the alleged offence.

- (4) Where in any prosecution under this section evidence is tendered of the analysis of a specimen of the blood of any person, it shall be presumed, in the absence of evidence to the contrary, that any syringe used for taking the specimen of blood and the receptacle in which such specimen was placed for despatch to an analyst, were free of any substance or contamination which could have affected the result of such analysis.
 - (5) Any person who on a public road -
 - (a) drives a vehicle; or
 - (b) occupies the driver's seat of a motor vehicle of which the engine is running,

while the concentration of alcohol in any specimen of breath exhaled by such person exceeds 0,37 milligrams per 1 000 millilitres, shall be guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding N\$8 000 or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding two years, or to both such fine and imprisonment.

- (6) If, in any prosecution for a contravention of subsection (5), it is proved that the concentration of alcohol in any specimen of breath of the person concerned exceeded 0,37 milligrams per 1 000 millilitres of breath taken at any time within two hours after the alleged offence, it shall be presumed, in the absence of evidence to the contrary, that such concentration exceeded 0,37 milligrams per 1 000 millilitres at the time of the alleged offence.
- (7) For the purposes of subsection (5), the concentration of alcohol in any breath specimen shall be ascertained by means of a device complying with the requirements of standard specification SABS 1793: 1998 Evidential breath testing equipment.
- (8) Any person detained for a contravention of any provision of this section shall not during his or her detention consume any substance containing alcohol, except on the instruction of, or when administered by, a medical practitioner.
- (9) Any person who without reasonable excuse for health reasons fails to comply with a request made under this section by a traffic officer to provide a specimen of breath or to submit to the taking of a specimen of his or her blood, shall be guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding N\$8 000 or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding two years, or to both such fine and imprisonment.".
