GENERAL ELECTION OF MEMBERS OF LOCAL AUTHORITY COUNCIL FOR REHOBOTH TOWN: DETERMINATION OF DAY AND PLACE FOR SUBMISSION OF NOMINATIONS OF CANDIDATES AND POLLING DAY: ELECTORAL ACT, 1992

Under the powers vested in me by subsection (1) of section 50 of the Electoral Act, 1992 (Act No. 24 of 1992), I make known, in relation to the election of members of the local authority council for Rehoboth Town, that I have determined -

- Wednesday 20 June 2001 as the day on which a public sitting shall be held (a) for the submission of nominations of candidates for that election, and that it shall be held from 09h00 until 11h00 at the Magistrate's Office, Rehoboth;
- Thursday 26 July 2001 as the day on which the poll shall be taken at that (b) election.
