No. 1 2005

PROHIBITION UNDER THE MEAT INDUSTRY ACT, 1981 (ACT NO. 12 OF 1981), PERTAINING TO THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF CERTAIN CONTROLLED PRODUCTS

Under section 20 of the Meat Industry Act, 1981 (Act No. 12 of 1981), and after consultation with the Meat Board of Namibia, I with effect from 1 March 2005-

- (a) withdraw Government Notice No. 129 of 1 June 2004; and
- (b) prohibit the import into or the export from Namibia of-
 - (i) cattle, sheep, goats and pigs, other than stud stock;
 - (ii) meat and meat products for purposes of sale,

except by a person who is the holder of a permit issued at the discretion of the board and in accordance with such conditions as may be stated by the board in such permit and subject thereto that such person-

- (aa) is registered as contemplated in section 10(1)(*l*) of the Meat Industry Act, 1981; and
- (bb) is permitted, in the case of the export of sheep from Namibia, to export only such quantity of sheep which in number does not exceed 50 per cent of the total number of sheep which such person has from that date delivered or caused to the delivered to an abattoir in Namibia for slaughtering and which has been slaughtered.

EXEMPTION FROM THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 92(1)(c) OF THE ROAD, TRAFFIC AND TRANSPORT ACT AND REGULATIONS 336, 337 AND 338 OF THE REGULATIONS PROMULGATED BY GOVERNMENT NOTICE NO. 53 OF 30 MARCH 2001: ROAD, TRAFFIC AND TRANSPORT ACT, 1999

In terms of section 105 of the Road, Traffic and Transport Act, 1999 (Act No. 22 of 1999), I —

(a) exempt the persons mentioned in Column 1 of the Schedule from the provisions of section 92(1)(c) of that Act and regulations 336, 337, and 338 of the Road, Traffic and Transport Regulations promulgated by Government Notice No. 53 of 30 March 2001, in respect of any place in Namibia;

Provided that as long as a disc bearing the number mentioned in column 2 of the Schedule and issued by the Deputy Director: Transportation Legislation Division on behalf of the Minister of Works, Transport and Communication, is displayed on the windscreen of the motor vehicle concerned; and

(b) repeal Government Notice No. 32 of 1 March 2003.
