#### MINISTRY OF WORKS, TRANSPORT AND COMMUNICATION

### AMENDMENT TO ROAD TRAFFIC AND TRANSPORT REGULATIONS: ROAD TRAFFIC AND TRANSPORT ACT, 1999

The Minister of Works, Transport and Communication has under section 91 of the Road Traffic and Transport Act, 1999 (Act No. 22 of 1999), made the regulations as set out in the Schedule.

#### **SCHEDULE**

1. In these regulations, "the Regulations" means the Road Traffic and Transport Regulations promulgated under Government Notice No. 53 of 30 March 2001, as amended by Government Notices Nos 97 of 29 May 2001, 103 of 01 July 2002, 161 of 26 September 2002, 163 of 26 September 2002 and 205 and 206 of 28 September 2004.

#### Substitution of regulation 120 of the Regulations

2. The following regulation is substituted for regulation 120 of the Regulations:

#### "Manner of application for issue of duplicate learner's or driving licence

- **120.** (1) An application for the issue of a duplicate learners' licence must be made by the holder of the original learner's licence to the driving testing centre on an approved form, which must be accompanied by -
  - (a) the fee prescribed in Schedule 1;
  - (b) acceptable identification of the applicant;
  - (c) the original learner's licence, or if the original is lost, stolen or destroyed, an affidavit to that effect by the applicant; and
  - (d) if, there is no capturing device available at the driving testing centre, two identical photographs of the applicant, which photographs comply with requirements of regulation 115(4).
- (2) On receipt of an application referred to in subregulation (1), the driving testing centre must -
  - (a) determine whether the applicant is a holder of a valid learner's licence;
  - (b) ensure that the learner's licence referred to in paragraph (a) is not subject to suspension or cancellation; and
  - (c) issue to the applicant a duplicate learner's licence in accordance with regulations 115, which applies with necessary changes to this regulation.
- (3) An application for the issue of a duplicate driving licence must be made by -
  - (a) the holder of the original driving licence; or

(b) by a person nominated by the holder of the original driving licence, if the holder is unable to apply as contemplated in paragraph (a),

to the driving testing centre on an approved form.

- (4) The form referred to in subregulation (3) must -
- (a) in the case of subregulation (3)(a), be accompanied by -
  - (i) the fee prescribed in Schedule 1;
  - (ii) the acceptable identification of the applicant;
  - (iii) the original driving licence in the case where the original licence is defaced, or if the original licence is lost, stolen or destroyed, an affidavit to that effect by the applicant; and
  - (iv) if the applicant is unable to collect the duplicate driving licence card from the driving testing centre in person, an authorisation as contemplated in regulation 119;
- (b) in the case of subregulation (3)(b), in addition to the requirements listed in paragraph (a)(i), (iii) and (iv), be accompanied by -
  - (i) acceptable identification of the nominee;
  - (ii) a certified copy of the acceptable identification of the holder of the original driving licence; and
  - (iii) a letter of nomination signed by the holder of the original driving licence containing the date of nomination, the reasons for nomination the type of nomination, and if applicable the number of the acceptable identification of the person nominated.
- (5) On receipt of an application referred to in subregulation (3), the driving testing centre concerned must -
  - (a) determine whether the applicant or person on whose behalf the application is made is a holder of a valid driving licence;
  - (b) ensure that the driving licence is not subject to suspension or cancellation; and
  - (c) issue to the applicant or person as the case may be a duplicate driving licence in accordance with regulation 118 which applies with necessary changes to this regulation.".

#### Amendment of Schedule 1 to the Regulations

- **3.** Schedule 1 to the Regulations is amended with effect from 28 September 2004 -
  - (a) by the substitution in item 12 of that Schedule for the fee "155.00" of the fee "150.00"; and
  - (b) by the substitution in item 13 of that Schedule for the fee "155.00" of the fee" "150.00".
