## 3. ENQUIRY FEE

In respect of an enquiry regarding the payment of a particular postal order or any enquiry regarding a postal order that has been lost or destroyed or mutilated to such an extent that the serial numbers are illegible, a fee of N\$ $\qquad$ per postal order shall be payable.
