INVITATION FOR APPLICATIONS TO FILL CASUAL VACANCY ON ELECTORAL COMMISSION: ELECTORAL ACT, 1992

In terms of section 5(2) of the Electoral Act, (Act No. 24 of 1992) read with section 8 of that Act, I invite any person to apply, in writing, for appointment as a member of the Electoral Commission for the remainder of the unexpired portion of the period of the vacated office, ending 17 August 2009.

An application must be accompanied by comprehensive curriculum vitae, certified copies of the applicant's identity and relevant academic qualifications and any other relevant documentation.

- 1. An applicant must have -
- (a) at least a three year bachelor degree or equivalent, preferably in the field of Law, Political Science, Social Science, and Public Administration;

- (b) a thorough knowledge and understanding of Namibian politics, history, culture, issues and trends relating to democracy and elections in Namibia and generally in the SADC region and in other parts of the world;
- (c) a sense of integrity, independence of mind and original and critical thinking skills in the execution of his or her electoral duties;
- (d) a firm commitment to the principles of fairness, political neutrality and equality;
- (e) an irreproachable professional standing;
- (f) extensive experience and outstanding acumen in conflict resolution, negotiation and mediation;
- 2. After the closing date, the Selection Committee established in terms of section 5(12) of the Electoral Act, 1992 must short-list and interview the applicants and such interviews are open to the public. The committee must in writing recommend to the President suitable applicants to be considered for appointment to fill the vacancy.
- 3. An applicant, if appointed as a member of the Electoral Commission -
- (a) is collectively responsible for directing, supervising and controlling, in a fair, impartial, transparent and professional manner the electoral processes in Namibia;
- (b) must attend monthly Electoral Commission meetings during the electoral off-season and more frequently during the election periods;
- (c) must undertake to travel within Namibia as well as outside Namibia, when required by the Electoral Commission;
- (d) is entitled to sitting and honorarium allowances, subject to certain conditions of service
