# IMPOSITION OF LEVY ON ELECTRICITY: ELECTRICITY ACT, 2000

Under section 13 of the Electricity Act, 2000 (Act No. 2 of 2000), I-

- (a) impose a levy on electricity supplied by NamPower (Pty) Ltd as a transmission licensee, set out in the Schedule; and
- (b) repeal Government Notice No. 145 of 16 July 2001.

# **SCHEDULE**

### LEVY ON ELECTRICITY SUPPLIED BY NAMPOWER (PTY) LTD

# **Amount of levy**

1. The amount of the levy imposed is 0.6 cents per unit of electricity supplied by NamPower (Pty) Ltd to a customer in Namibia and which units must be measured, for the purposes of such levy, in kilowatthour at the point where those units exit NamPower (Pty) Ltd's transmission system.

## Times of payment of levy

- 2. (1) The levy is payable monthly in arrears in respect of the sum total of units of electricity contemplated in item 1 during the relevant month and must be paid to the Electricity Control Board established under section 2 of the Electricity Act, 2000, not later than -
  - (a) the 20th day of the month following the month in respect of which the levy is payable; or
  - (b) if the 20th day referred to in paragraph (a) falls on a Saturday, a Sunday or a public holiday, the first business day thereafter.
- (2) The levy is payable on the sum total of units of electricity contemplated in item 1 in so far as the customer contemplated in that item paid for such electricity and must be paid to the Electricity Control Board without any deductions.

### **Interest on late payment**

3. If the amount payable in respect of the levy is not paid by NamPower (Pty) Ltd in accordance with item (2), by the last day for payment as stipulated in that item, NamPower (Pty) Ltd must pay interest on the outstanding amount, compounded daily, from the date following that last day at a rate equivalent to the normal annual interest rate charged by commercial banks in Namibia on overdraft accounts and subject to any fluctuation in that rate, during the period that the amount in question or any portion thereof remains unpaid.

# AMENDMENT OF SCHEDULE 1: CUSTOMS AND EXCISE ACT, 1998

Under section 54(2)(a)(v) of the Customs and Excise Act, 1998 (Act No. 20 of 1998), I -

- (a) amend Schedule 1 of that Act as set out in the Schedule; and
- (b) state that under Article 26 of the Customs Union Agreement 2002, the additional rate of duty will be levied equally on such goods manufactured in the other parts of the common customs area and like goods imported from outside that area, irrespective of whether the latter goods are imported directly or from the area of any other party to the Customs Union Agreement, 2002, and subject to the payment of the customs duties applicable to such goods on importation into the common customs area.
