DECLARATION OF KHOMASDAL EXTENSION 16 TO BE AN APPROVED TOWNSHIP: MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF WINDHOEK

In terms of section 13 of the Townships and Division of Land Ordinance, 1963 (Ordinance 11 of 1963), I hereby declare the area situated on Portion 260 of the Farm Windhoek Town and Town Lands No. 31 in the Registration Division "K" as indicated on General Plan No. K257 to be an approved township.

The conditions, subject to which the application for permission to establish township concerned has been granted, are set forth in the Schedule below in terms of the said section 13.

SCHEDULE

1. Name of Township:

The name of the Township shall be **Khomasdal Extension 16.**

2. Composition of Township:

The Township comprises of 704 erven numbered 5220 to 5771, 6382 to 6533 and the remainder streets as indicated on General Plan K 257.

3. Conditions of title:

The following conditions shall be registered in favour of the Local Authority against the title deeds of all erven:

- a) The erf shall only be used or occupied for purposes which are in accordance with and the use or occupation of the erf shall at all times be subject to the provisions of the Windhoek Town Planning Scheme prepared and approved in terms of the Town Planning Ordinance, 1954 (Ordinance 18 of 1954) as amended.
- b) The building value of the main building, excluding the outbuilding, must be at least four times the municipal valuation of the erf.

NOTIFICATION IN TERMS OF SECTION 109(3) OF THE MINERALS (PROSPECTING AND MINING) ACT, 1992

In terms of subsection (3) of section 109 of the Minerals (Prospecting and Mining) Act, 1992 (Act No. 33 of 1992), it is made known that -

- (d) any person whose interests may be prejudicially affected by the granting of the rights mentioned in the Table may appear before the Minerals Ancillary Rights Commission personally or through a legal representative during the period referred to in paragraph (c).
