#### LUSAKA

- Air Namibia was granted 5th Freedom traffic rights between Johannesburg and Lusaka by the South African and Lusaka Authorities;
- Air Namibia worked closely with the Directorate of Civil Aviation and the Ministry of Works and Transport as liaison between Namibia, South Africa and Lusaka, who assisted in this regard;
- All the required permits from the relevant authorities of South Africa and Lusaka, were subsequently issued;
- Air Namibia already commenced operations on this route on 25 October 2009;
- 5. This project and proposal is in line with Air Namibia's business plan of enhancing revenue generation capacity through expansion and participation in new markets, while at the same time aiming to improve market share and revenue in Air Namibia's traditional / existing markets;
- Air Namibia concluded a commercial partnership agreements with Zambezi Airlines, in order to improve competitiveness on the route;
- Air Namibia appointed a GSA as its sales force from the Zambian side for the first 12 months as part of the trial phase, prior to establishing permanent offices and employees in the region;
- 8. Air Namibia already entered into an ACMI Lease agreement for this operation.
