DETERMINATION OF TOTAL ALLOWABLE CATCH IN RESPECT OF HORSE MACKEREL, PILCHARD AND CRAB: MARINE RESOURCES ACT, 2000

Under section 38 of the Marine Resources Act, 2000 (Act No. 27 of 2000) and having requested the advice of the Marine Resources Advisory Council, I determine on the basis of the best scientific evidence available that the total allowable catch for the purpose of limiting the quantity of horse mackerel, pilchard and crab which may be harvested during the period of 1 January 2011 to 31 December 2011 is as specified in the second column, of the Table, directly opposite the marine resources mentioned in the first column of that Table.

 - Erven 4218 to 4222, for public open space purposes.

4. Conditions of title:

- (1) The following condition shall be registered in favour of the Local Authority against the title deeds of all erven except the erven mentioned in paragraph 3.
