ANNOUNCEMENT IN TERMS OF ARTICLE 32(8) OF THE NAMIBIAN CONSTITUTION OF CONFERMENT OF CERTAIN HONOURS ON THE LATE ROSALIA ANNETTE NDILINASHO NGHIDINWA

In terms of Sub-Article (8) of Article 32 of the Namibian Constitution, I announce that I have, under the powers vested in me by Sub-Article (3)(h) of that Article read with section 3(1) of the Conferment of National Honours Act, 2012 (Act No. 11 of 2012) directed that -

- (a) a state Funeral be held in honour of the Late Rosalia Annette Ndilinasho Nghidinwa (born 26 October 1952 and died on 14 January 2018); and
- (b) her remains be interred at the burial site of the Nkurenkuru Village situate in the Kavango West Region on Saturday, 27 January 2018.

ANNOUNCEMENT IN TERMS OF ARTICLE 32(8) OF THE NAMIBIAN
CONSTITUTION OF CONFERMENT OF CERTAIN HONOURS ON THE LATE
ISAK ASHINKONO “NANGATA” SHOOME

In terms of Sub-Article (8) of Article 32 of the Namibian Constitution, I announce that I have, under the powers vested in me by Sub-Article (3)(h) of that Article read with section 3(1) of the Conferment of National Honours Act, 2012 (Act No. 11 of 2012) directed that -

- (a) a state Funeral be held in honour of the Late Isak Ashinkono “Nangata” Shoome (born 11 May 1916 and died on 12 December 2017);
- (b) his remains be interred at the Omugulu-Gwoombashe Heritage Site, Omusati Region on Saturday, 24 December 2017;
- (c) a period of national mourning be observed in honour of the Late Isak Ashinkono “Nangata” Shoome; and
- (d) that all flags in Namibia be flown at half-mast with effect from Thursday, 21 December to Saturday, 24 December 2017, and that period to be the period of national mourning.
