PROPOSAL THAT PORTIONS OF ROADS BE CLOSED AND PORTIONS OF ROADS BE RECLASSIFIED: DISTRICT OF SWAKOPMUND

In terms of section 20(1)(c) and (e) of the Roads Ordinance, 1972 (Ordinance No. 17 of 1972), it is hereby made known that the Roads Authority on behalf of the Executive Director: Works and Transport proposes that, in the district of Swakopmund:

- (a) the classification of a portion of main road 36 described in Schedule I and shown on sketchmap P2399 by the symbols A-B be changed to a portion of trunk road 2/1;
- (b) the classification of a portion of main road 44 described in Schedule II and shown on sketch-map P2399 by the symbols B-C-D be changed to a portion of trunk road 2/1;
- (c) the classification of a portion of trunk road 2/1 described in Schedule III and shown on sketch-map P2399 by the symbols A-E-F-G-H-I-J be changed to main road (number 54);
- (d) a portion of trunk road 2/1 be closed as described in Schedule IV and shown on sketch- map P2399 by the symbols J-K;
- (e) a portion of trunk road 2/2 be closed as described in Schedule V and shown on sketch- map P2399 by the symbols D1-K-L; and
- (f) the classification of a portion of trunk road 2/2 described in Schedule VI and shown on sketch-map P2399 by the symbols D-D1 be changed to district road (number 1906).

A copy of this notice and the said sketch-map on which the road to which the proposal refers and other proclaimed, minor and private roads in the area are shown, shall for the full period of 30 days, mentioned below, lie open to inspection at the offices of the Roads Authority, Windhoek, during normal office hours.

DETERMINATION OF PREMIUMS PAYABLE PER RISK CATEGORY AND INTEREST RATES PAYABLE BY MEMBER INSTITUTION: DEPOSIT GUARANTEE ACT, 2018

Under section 57(1)(b) read with section 34(1) and (2) of the Deposit Guarantee Act, 2018 (Act No. 16 of 2018), with the approval of the Minister of Finance, the Namibia Deposit Guarantee Authority has determined the premiums payable per risk category and the rate of interest payable by a member institution on outstanding balance for the benefit of the Deposit Guarantee Fund as set out in Schedule.

E. UANGUTA CHAIRPERSON NAMIBIA DEPOSIT GUARANTEE AUTHORITY

Premium payable per risk category

1. (1) The premium payable per risk category by a member institution for the benefit of the Fund is set out in the Table.

Risk Category	Basis Point Per Category
Category 1	8 basis points
Category 2	16 basis points
Category 3	32 basis points
Category 4	64 basis points

- (2) Every member institution is rated to be a category 1 institution with premiums set at 8 basis points until 31 December 2021.
- (3) A premium referred to in subparagraph (1) is payable on or before 31 March each year.
- (4) A member institution may not recover the premiums referred to in this determination from depositors by way of a direct charge on deposits.

Interest rate

2. A member institution that fails or refuses to pay the premium in full on or before the date specified in paragraph 1(3) is liable to pay 20% interest per annum on the outstanding balance.
