1. Unpaid debts in respect of charges, fees, rates and/or other moneys as determined and payable under the Local Authorities Act, 1992 (Act No. 23 of 1992) or on unpaid debts under any other law, the Council will charge interest, at a rate, not exceeding the rate prescribed under the provisions of the Prescribed Rate of Interest Act, 1975 (Act No. 55 of 1975), which may be charged in respect of judgment debt of a Magistrate's Court and which will be adjusted in line with the same determined and adjusted from time to time. Fixed interest rate is thus for the time being determined at 20% per annum. All previous notices in respect of payment of late fees or intest rate on late payments are rescinded.
