The Law Reform and Development Commission (LRDC) is mandated in terms of section 6 of the Law Reform and Development Commission Act, 1991 (Act No. 29 of 1991) (as amended) to undertake research and to examine all branches of Namibian law in order to make recommendations for the reform and development thereof.

In pursuance of this mandate, the LRDC is in the process of finalizing the review of the Insolvency Act, 1936 (Act No. 24 of 1936), resulting in the formulation of the Insolvency Bill. The Insolvency Bill is proposed to repeal the Insolvency Act, 1936 and will apply in terms of clause 2, to any debtor with a centre of main interest in Namibia or to a debtor who has an establishment in Namibia.

The LRDC recognizes the need to engage the public, government and civil society on insolvency issues that affect natural and juristic debtors, as well as their creditors, and we are thus pleased to invite members of the public to a National Consultative Workshop on the Insolvency Bill. This National Consultative Workshop on the Insolvency Bill will take place from 20 to 23 November 2018, at the BON Hotel, Swakopmund, and will subject the proposed Insolvency Bill to final consultations with stakeholders in order to finalize the review process of the Insolvency Act, 1936.
